

ANTICIPATED TIMELINE

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| June 15, 2020 | Soft opening Schaffer Law Library — bar students only. |
| July 1 | Open faculty offices. Daily health screening required. |
| July 8 | Open Schaffer Law Library and third floor of 2000 Building to summer school students. |
| July 15 | DEPARTMENT HEADS: Due to Director of Human Resources—plans for remote/staggered work. |
| July 24 | Begin to accept reopening plans by student organizations for their offices. Open on approval by Office of Student Affairs and Health and Safety group. |
| August 3 | Implementation of daily health screening for all employees. Staff to return to work, based on approved departmental plans. |
| August 3–23 | FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS, FACULTY, AND STAFF ATTENDING ORIENTATION ON CAMPUS: Provide proof of negative COVID-19 test completed within the period of August 3 to August 17. STUDENTS, FACULTY, AND STAFF RETURNING TO CAMPUS: Provide proof of negative COVID-19 test completed within the period of August 9 to August 23. A negative test is required for all faculty, students, and staff intending to be physically on campus during the fall semester. Proof of negative test for faculty, students, and staff to be sent to the Office of Human Resources. |
| August 17 | New student Orientation begins on campus and remotely. |
| August 24 | Classes begin; common areas, library, gym, cafeteria, unused classrooms available for study with physical distancing; all events and meetings to be held remotely. |
| No sooner than September 7 | Students may reserve rooms for meetings and events limited to students, faculty, and staff. Physical distancing rules apply. All in-person meetings to be available to remote students. No outside visitors except via Zoom or other remote option. Faculty and staff meetings to be held via Zoom. |
| No sooner than September 28 | Student groups may invite select outside guests to join in meetings and events, with permission of the leadership of Albany Law School. Physical distancing, health |

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| | screening, hygiene, and face covering rules must be strictly enforced. Faculty and staff will continue to hold meetings remotely via Zoom. |
| November 24 | Last day of in-person classes. |
| November 25–27 | Thanksgiving break. |
| November 30– December 4 | All classes to be held in remote format. Opening of library and other facilities for student use to be determined. |
| December 9–21 | Exams — all exams will be conducted online. |
