Margot has also served as the Director of the Guam Office of Child Support Enforcement within the Guam Attorney General's Office. She began her career in the Guam Attorney General's Office in 1980 and served as an Assistant Attorney General in several divisions, including the Prosecution, Civil Litigation and Family Divisions.
